-- Prop. 19 Legalize marijuana, except for impaired driving and users under 21.

We see no need to make a change and wish it wasn't on ballot, but also see some arguments that govt. intrusion is unwarranted. Feds. definitely have no business here. We see the value of restricting minors' use.

YES* PROP. 20 Redistricting of Congressional districts by Citizens' Redistricting Committee rather than by politicians. See # 27 which is the opposite.

NO Prop. 21 The proposition would impose an annual \$18 vehicle license surcharge for state parks and wildlife.

-- Prop. 22 prohibits state from taking local funds dedicated to local governments community redevelopment or transportation projects. Some drawbacks- read our election forum- Propositions.

YES* Prop. 23 Suspends the State's Cap & Trade Law until the state's unemployment rate is 5.5% or less.

California Board Reportedly Overestimated Pollution by 340 Percent to Pass Landmark Air Standards

This 340% erroneous "estimate" helped create AB32. This is but one of three such errors reported. AB32 is therefore based on trumped up projections and is financial suicide for California

NO Prop. 24 A NO vote allows businesses to retain existing tax breaks.

NO* Prop. 25 A NO vote retains a 2/3 vote to pass a state budget.

YES* Prop. A YES vote requires a 2/3 vote to increase levies and charges (taxes by other names) rather than simple majority.

NO* Prop.27 The proposition would eliminate the state commission on redistricting and would allow politicians to determine district boundaries.

* Props. are critical.
