14 out of the 15 students responded (**93%**) to the questions administered in the end course evaluation forms provided.

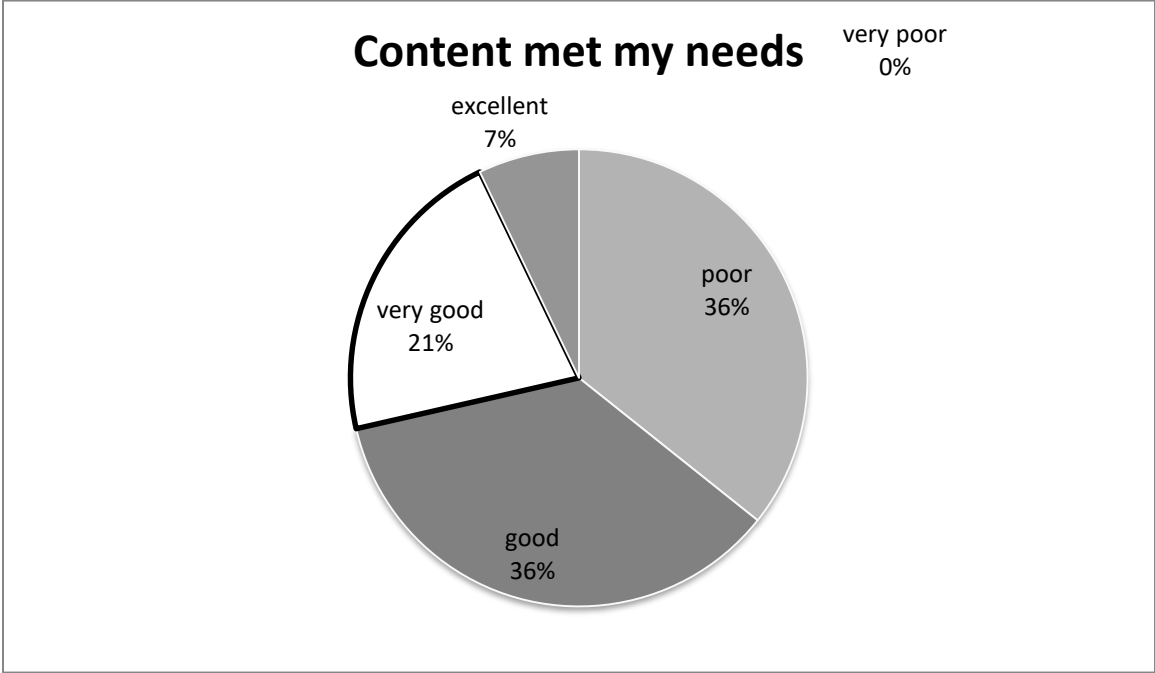
The forms had questions in **four categories**;

- d. Overall evaluation/recommendation

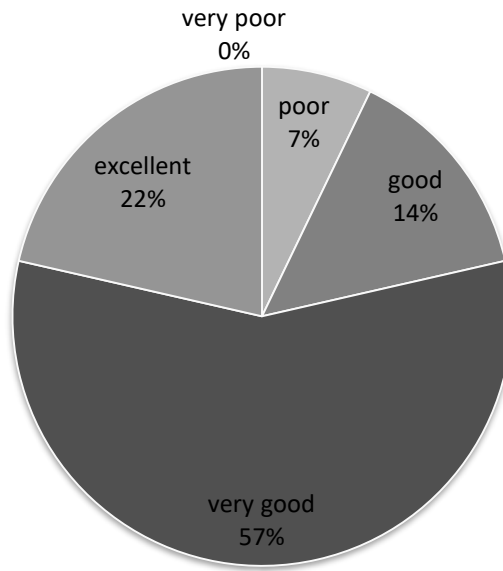
