

ABOUT THE COLLEGE

St. Francis College for women (an autonomous college of Osmania University) was founded in 1959 with a mission of providing holistic education to women students. After 26 years of autonomy, the college was awarded the prestigious CPE status (2004,2014). It is the first college in erstwhile united Andhra Pradesh and Telangana to undertake three accreditation cycles receiving the highest rating of 5 stars and an A Grade by NAAC.

The college focuses on the all round development of students. The college imparts value based education to students and endeavours to make them intellectually competent, morally upright, socially committed and spiritually inspired women citizens of India. The college offers UG and PG courses in the faculties of Sciences, Arts, Commerce and Management. The college has autonomous status at both UG & PG level. (CBCS) was introduced in June 2016.
